## Volcano Experiments

- 1/2 c. hydrogen peroxide
- 1/2 TBSP quick rising yeast
- 1 c. ketchup
- 5 TBSP baking soda
- 3 squirts of dish soap
- 1/2 cup lemon juice
- 1/2 cup vinegar

## Underwater Volcano Experiment

- large clear glass jar or vase
- smaller clear glass jar that fits inside the larger jar or vase

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- red food coloring
- rock

#### Balloon Gas Experiment

- Narrow-necked bottle (such as a glass Rootbeer bottle)
- Balloon
- 1/3 c. Baking Soda
- 1 c. Vinegar
- Small Funnel

## Rainshadow Experiment

- Newspaper or other paper to form mountains
- Fan
- Spray bottle

# Chapter 4

## Canyon Carving Activity

- 2 cups cornmeal
- 1 cup flour
- 1 cup salt
- spray bottle
- rectangular container
- 1-2 ice cubes with gravel frozen in them (optional)

## Tsunami Experiment

- Plastic container
- Dirt
- Sand
- Plastic cup or other item to push water
- Houses/cars to replicate a village



#### Great Wave Watercolor

- Watercolor set
- Brush or water pen
- Watercolor paper
- Pencil

#### Evaporation Experiment

- 2 plastic ziplock bags
- Sharpie marker
- Tape (recommend blue) painter's tape)
- Blue food coloring

## Popsicle Longhouse Activity

- 15 regular popsicle sticks

- Empty 2-liter bottle
- Coffee filter
- Dirty water

#### Variety of filtration materials, such as:

- Sand
- Pebbles
- Gravel
- Sticks
- Cotton balls
- Rocks
- Weeds/algae
- Activated charcoal

## Estuaries Experiment

- 8 TBSP salt (1/2 cup)
- Spoon or whisk to stir

- 1 gallon water (16 cups)
- 2 opposite colors food dye
- 1 large clear container that will hold 16 cups
- 1 container that will hold 8 cups

## Longhouse on Beach Watercolor

- 5x7 piece of watercolor paper
- Watercolors
- Brush or water pen
- Narrow brush
- Longhouse cutout

## Cree Octopus Bag Activity

- Sewing machine or needle and thread to pre-sew the pouch
- Scissors
- Felt
- Chalk marker (optional)
- Puff paint
- Beads (preferably blue) and white)

- 12 wide popsicle sticks 6 regular popsicle sticks
- 8 craft matchsticks
- craft glue
- sharp scissors
- hot glue gun and glue

- Watercolor set
- Brush or water pen
- Watercolor paper
- Pencil

- Elmer's (or craft) glue
- Black acrylic paint

- 1 cup white flour

- 2 Liter Diet Coke

## Popsicle Wagon Activity

- 18-20 regular popsicle sticks
- 1 wide popsicle stick cut in half with curved ends cut off
- 4 craft match sticks (or 2 more popsicle sticks cut in half)
- 6 brown chenille stems\*
- Pick a size paper towel
- Something to cut the popsicle sticks and chenille stems (I used tin cutters)
- Hot glue gun & glue

# \*OPTIONAL CARDBOARD WHEELS MATERIALS:

- Cardboard wheels kit
- 1 Straw
- 1 Vegetable skewer
- 1 Extra popsicle stick (If you use the wheels cutout kit, you only need 2 chenille stems.)

- sink or large container
